The Conference will be held at Hilton Dalaman Hotel, Sarigerme, Turkey, 13 – 17 October 2014. The Conference site is situated on Turkey's southwestern coastline on the Mediterranean Sea. It will be followed by 3 days of optional excursions to Ephesus or Blue Mediterranean tour.  economics, cost/benefit analysis, decision making models, legislation and policies, participatory methods
 / water user partnerships, and criteria to evaluate / assess watershed management implementation.
- Models: Integrated environmental model applications for management including watershed, air shed, coastal, and living resource models.
- Adaptive water resources management: To evaluate and adress trans—boundary environmental issues including climate change, air pollution, coastal ocean effects at regional, continental, and global scales.
- Global watershed sustainability: Establishment of a Sustainable Use Watershed Management Seal
 of Excellence Award initiative that recognizes outstanding programs worldwide.

Please submit an extended abstract of less than 3 pages or 1000 words, summarizing the proposed presentation and email: suwama2014.conference@igemportal.org by 17th March 2014. Contributions from a broad spectrum of sustainable watershed management issues are welcome. Submissions will be judged on relevance to conference themes, clarity of thought, data/documented results, creativity, and other criteria. Deadline for notification of acceptance is 31st March 2014.
